

WHAT: Columbia Gas and its contractor Miller Pipeline are set to begin a replacement project in Cardington.

WHERE: Crews are installing approximately 1,700 feet of new plastic pipe serving roughly 20 properties on Marion between 2nd and Nichols, as well as on Nichols between Marion and Center.

WHEN: Construction should begin the week of March 25th.

WHY: This project is necessary to remedy existing leakage. Other longer-term benefits:

- Enhanced safety features
- Less future maintenance
- Reliability of service
- Pipe lifespan of 100 years
- Increased system support and capacity
